When we made the decision to reopen for in-person worship in April 2022, we made every attempt to follow current CDC guidelines and have continued to seek ways to keep each of you safe and comfortable.

As an additional layer of protection against air borne viruses and bacteria, Far UVC Sanitation Lights have been placed throughout the sanctuary.

Based on the most recent study, 99.9% of pathogens have been continuously inactivated. This is real-time mitigation when we are in the spaces of the sanctuary. Surface sanitation within the sanctuary is also occurring.

Therefore, wearing a mask in the sanctuary will no longer be mandatory but may be worn at the discretion of each individual. Mask in other areas of the church are still required.
